

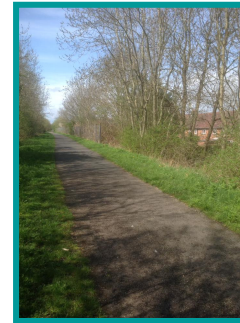
Rides for All

Mickle Trafford Trundle
Saturday 18 May - 1 pm start
Meeting @ the Greenway entrance to Northgate Pond for a short round trip along the Greenway towards Mickle Trafford with a stop off at Meadow Lea café for tea and cake.



Trees Trail
Saturday 15 June - 1 pm start
Meeting @ the Greenway entrance to Northgate Pond for a ride along the Greenway spotting the different trees in their spring foliage.



Animal Amble
Saturday 20 July - 1 pm start
Meeting @ the Greenway entrance to Northgate Pond and following the traffic free Greenway in both directions for a few miles to discover the animal sculptures along the way - there's a woodpecker and a horse and more to find.
