Cheshire Cycleway	reclassify	The Cheshire Cycleway was incorporated within the Network many years ago but as on-road cycleway, with increasing levels of traffic it does not fit within the future vision for the Network and the 'Paths for Everyone' standards we have set. The Cycleway is therefore proposed for reclassification, this will mean that it will lose its Regional Route status, but will still be shown on the Sustrans web map, annotated to indicate the cycleway being of different character to the Network and more suited to touring and sports cyclists. Cover over RR70 number, Cheshire Cycleway name remains. Highways Authority required to cover NCN number.	Set up meeting with councils, cycle groups, volunteers and others to determine how the cycleway is to be managed in the future.
Lancashire Cycleway	reclassify	The Lancashire Cycleway was incorporated within the Network many years ago but as on-road cycleway, with increasing levels of traffic it does not fit within the future vision for the Network and the 'Paths for Everyone' standards we have set. The Cycleway is therefore proposed for reclassification, this will mean that it will lose its Regional Route status, but will still be shown on the Sustrans web map, annotated to indicate the cycleway being of different character to the Network and more suited to touring and sports cyclists. Cover over RR90 and RR91 numbers, Lancashire Cycleway name remains. Highway Authority required to cover NCN number.
